How and Why We Obtain Information

United Marriage Encounter obtains non-public, personal information about you in the following ways:

- From you on applications, registrations, or forms (examples include name, address, date of marriage, e-mail address).
- From transactional activity (for example, credit card or bank account numbers for contributions).
- From other sources with your consent.

This information is used in order to provide you with the superior service you have come to expect from UME. For example, we use the data to process transactions, to respond to inquiries from you or others in UME who have need of this information, and to develop, offer, and deliver services.

How We Protect Your Information
